Mathematical skills and development

<u>Year 2</u>

As mathematicians, we will be learning the place value of two digit numbers, adding and subtracting one more/ less from any two digit number and counting in twos, fives and tens. We will also be using concrete resources to add and subtract from a two digit number.

<u>Year 3</u>

As mathematicians, we will be learning the place value of three digit numbers, adding and subtracting ten more/less from any two digit number and building on our knowledge of counting in twos, fives and tens, to counting in threes and fours. We will also be using formal written methods for adding and subtracting two numbers.

As musicians, we will be learning Sea Shanty's which link to our topic of Land Ahoy.
